

Category Trolleys



Board trolleys have two or four wheels and are designed specifically to transport long and large items such as furniture cases, boards, sheet panels, mattresses and mirrors. Board trolleys can be used in the shop area, in the stockroom and when receiving and delivering goods. They are specifically suited for transporting boards and similar in an upright position.

Benefits

- Products can be transported rather than carried
- Bulky and difficult-to-handle products can be handled by a single employee
- There are many different types and models of board trolley on the market, so you can choose the type best suited to the types of products and tasks at hand

Requirements for use

- The board trolley should be suited for the product and task at hand, for example with regard to size, load capacity and type of wheels
- There should be room to move and manoeuvre the board trolley
- The surface of transport routes should be even, stable, level and without holes, and the route should be well lit

Considerations prior to procurement

- What types of boards or other loads do we want to handle using a board trolley?
- What are our requirements for the board trolley, for example with regard to design, size, handles, load capacity, type of wheels and manoeuvrability, etc.?

After procurement

- Inspect for deficiencies/defects before use
- Should be maintained as described in the instructions for use
- Employees should be instructed in how and for what tasks the board trolley should be used
- · Make sure the instructions are followed
